Introducing Foundation Daw Park: Raising Funds for medical Research at The Repat

Foundation Daw Park was established in the 1990's by veterans to raise funds for medical research and special projects to enhance quality patient care provided at Repatriation General Hospital often fondly referred to as The Repat.

The Repat's long tradition of caring and compassion has placed it at the forefront of hospital health care in South Australia. Known for decades for its dedication to the needs of war veterans, the hospital now extends its services to delivering health services to the older community across South Australia.

The Foundation has recently restructured at both Board and operational levels to increase its capacity and capabilities to substantially increase funding to The Repat. The appointment of Chris Jenner as Executive Director is an outcome of the restructure. Her corporate background, community involvements and leadership style are recognised as being key to the new direction the Foundation is heading. Commenting on her appointment, Chris said "I am proud to have been appointed to this role. I am leading a new team in a new direction and it is very exciting for us all."
